

## Long Term Acute Care (LTAC) Hospitals

The Myth: The cost of care is significantly less than acute care hospitals

The Fact: The cost of care may be higher than acute care hospitals

An emerging trend is evolving charge rates and claim practices for LTACs. The Branch team has identified:

- Room and Board Charges for reduced acuity services can exceed the average daily charge from the transferring acute care hospital.
- Non-payable charges including floor stock supplies and nursing/patient monitoring services may be billed which can materially impact the contract payable charges.
- Adverse patient events including nosocomial infection may significantly increase the claims as well as the length of stay.

Daily payable charge comparison LTAC versus Acute Care for same patient acuity and ancillary services:	LTAC 32 Days Inpatient Stay	Acute Care 32 Days Inpatient Stay
Billed Charges	\$559,962	\$416,934
Contract Payable Charge	\$363,975	\$250,160
Average Daily Payable Charge	\$11,374	\$7,818
Payable Charge Difference - \$	\$113,815	
Payable Charge Difference - %	45.5%
